This non-invasive procedure allows your doctor to see a much broader and more detailed view of the retina than is possible with conventional methods. When reviewed, the scan becomes a permanent part of your medical file, enabling your doctor to make important comparisons should potential vision threatening conditions show themselves at a future examination.

Our fee for the retinal screening, measurement and interpretation is \$39.00. We will collect this fee along with your co-payment and deductibles at the end of your visit.

This procedure will not be covered by insurance but is generally a reimbursable flexible spending (FSA) expense.
